

Youth Leadership Award

Purpose

The purpose of the Community Storehouse Youth Leadership Award is to identify young people who are working to make a difference in our community, and to recognize the hard work, determination and leadership they demonstrate in doing so.

Award

\$1000.00 College Scholarship

Eligibility

The program is open to all students between the ages of 15 and 18 attending or zoned for Keller, Carroll or Northwest Independent School Districts.

Requirements

Applicants must demonstrate leadership and ingenuity as trailblazers undertaking community initiatives that have measurable results. Initiatives must align with the Community Storehouse Mission Statement that we are *dedicated to the education and well-being of low-income children in our community.*

All submissions must showcase the applicant's work in video or photo gallery format and must be supported by a brief written summary that describes their leadership vision, details of their project, and how it aligns to the Community Storehouse Mission Statement.

All submissions must include two short letters of reference from non-family members (a page or less) which illustrate the character, personal traits and leadership of the applicant. If possible, these references should also speak to the effectiveness of the initiative being submitted.

All submissions must contain full name, address, telephone number, email address and the name of the school the applicant is currently attending. Submissions must be received by February 18, 2020 to be considered.
